INDIVIDUAL EQUIPMENT FOR RALLYS

Competitors are expected refer to the official USPC Horse Management required equipment checklists posted on USPC website.

In addition to **Appropriate Attire, Pony Club Pin, Saddle, Bridle, Cotton Lead Rope** and a **Leather or Breakaway halter**, competitors should have the following ***bold*** items for overnight rallies.

Grooming Kit (one per horse, ea item labeled w/ competitor's name)

- _____ **hoof pick**
- _____ **rub rag** labeled with competitor and club name
- _____ **dandy brush** (hard bristles- not too hard though)
- _____ **body brush** (soft bristles)
- _____ **2 sponges** (1 marked dock, 1 marked face)
- _____ **curry comb** (rubber or plastic capable of cleaning brushes)
- _____ mane comb
- _____ **body sponge**
- _____ **scraper and wash buckets** (marked wash only)

Extra Equipment (per team, capable of fitting all team horses, labeled with team name or #) Only 1 set is **required** per team but you may be asked to bring your own if your mount is unusually large or small or you use tall boots or peacocks Ask your Stable Manager!

- _____ extra girth
- _____ extra complete bridle
- _____ extra **break away or leather halter** (adjustable)
- _____ extra **cotton** lead rope
- _____ **2 rubber bands and leather straps for peacock irons (if used)**

Stall Equipment (per horse, labeled w/name and number)

- _____ **stall ID card** posted Check w/ SM. They sometimes want "matching" cards
- _____ **heavy-duty feed tub**
- _____ **2 (5 gal.) heavy-duty water buckets** (one always filled w fresh water)
- _____ **cotton lead rope**
- _____ **salt block** (holder optional, twine OK; loose salt OK)
- _____ **snaps** to secure tubs & buckets
- _____ **1 (5 gal.) water bucket** filled at night, to top off water buckets

Tack Room Equipment (with team name label)

- _____ saddle rack (per each saddle, labeled w/competitor name & #)
 - _____ bridle rack(per each bridle, labeled w/competitor #)
- Check with your Stable Manager. SCCPC has some sets with our Team Equip.

- _____ **boot trees (for tall boots, both leg and toe)**

Feeding equipment (per horse, labeled w/name or number)

- _____ **feed chart** posted Check w/ SM.They sometimes want "matching" charts
- _____ appropriate grain storage (no plastic, secure can for grain) Usually team equip
- _____ burlap, cloth or paper bags, or paper & twine for ea. hay feeding or scale
